What is a neighborhood pop-up?

A neighborhood pop-up is an event where we are invited to bring out our truck for a fun neighborhood event! Guests pay for their own food. This type of event works well for close knit neighborhoods with great internal communication avenues (Facebook, Nextdoor, etc.).

We love to visit areas outside of Savannah! Menu prices may be increased by \$1-\$2 to cover the expense of traveling to locations outside of a 20 mile radius.

Keep in mind - If your event is on private property, additional permits are usually not required. However, events on public property (city/county street) often require a local permit. It is the client's responsibility to verify that we can park and serve at an event site.

Why a food truck?

A restaurant on wheels, we come ready to serve! We provide all necessary items for a full-service experience, including serve ware, napkins & utensils. You don't have to do a thing!

Min. requirements?

Neighborhood Pop-Ups are self-pay by attendees. However, we may require a guarantee in sales.

Our truck requires 75 feet of space and 13 feet of overhead clearance.

Allergies?

We offer substitution options including corn tortillas, and salad greens. Ask about gluten free options and please let us know of any food allergies in advance.

Parking & permits?

Please be advised: Client must verify with either the City, County or HOA that we are allowed to park at the chosen event location site.
